2019 Earth Day Award Categories

Outstanding Corporate Friend of the Environment Award

Description: Awarded to a company that has shown exemplary dedication to improving the environment and protecting our valuable resources. Activities taken in consideration of this award must show substantial support of recycling, reusing and/or renewing resources and advocacy of the same within the community.

Outstanding Organizational Friend of the Environment Award

Description: Awarded to an organization that has shown exemplary dedication to improving the environment and protecting our valuable resources. Activities taken in consideration of this award must show substantial support of recycling, reusing and/or renewing resources and advocacy of the same within the community

Outstanding Individual Friend of the Environment Award

Description: Award is bestowed upon an individual who has exhibited a superior commitment to improving the environment through recycling, reusing and/or renewing resources and advocacy of the same within the community.

Environmental Steward of the Year Award

Description: Award is bestowed upon an individual, organization, or group, who has exhibited a superior commitment to improving the environment through recycling, reusing and/or renewing resources and advocacy of the same within the community.

Hutchcroft Environmental Youth Awards - Elementary

Description: Award is bestowed upon an Elementary School individual or group that exhibits an excellent commitment to improving the environment through recycling, reusing and/or renewing resources and advocacy of the same within the community.

Hutchcroft Environmental Youth Awards – Middle School

Description: Award is bestowed upon a Middle School individual or group that exhibits an excellent commitment to improving the environment through recycling, reusing and/or renewing resources and advocacy of the same within the community.

Hutchcroft Environmental Youth Awards - High School and College

Description: Award is bestowed upon a High School or College individual or group that exhibits an excellent commitment to improving the environment through recycling, reusing and/or renewing resources and advocacy of the same within the community.
